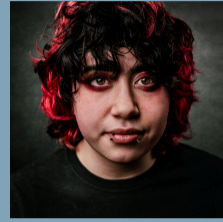
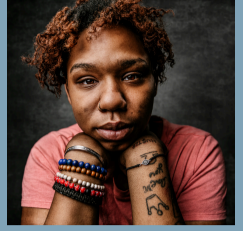

# UPDATE FROM THE CEO



Street homelessness in Kansas City has increased 30% in each of the last three years. Affordable housing is a critical, basic human need in short supply across greater Kansas City. At the same time, rising costs of rent, groceries, utilities, healthcare, and transportation practically guarantee that this number will not reduce on its own any time soon.

In 2023, we specifically saw the number of women, families, children, and seniors seeking our assistance rise. To help enhance the short- and long-term housing needs, we formalized our partnership with the Kansas City Missouri Public School District and Avenues of Life. This collaborative response is helping to provide absent resources and services that promise more stability and a clearer path forward. Similarly, partnerships with Healthy Blue, ReDiscover, the KCPD, KCFD, First Call, Drumm Farm, and Synergy Services allow us to remove barriers, identify causes, decrease trauma, and address the many needs of our neighbors facing or experiencing homelessness. Our vision is to end homelessness in Kansas City. With our passionate staff, dedicated volunteers, committed community leaders, and invested donors, we believe this is possible.

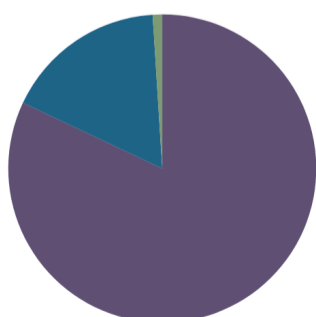

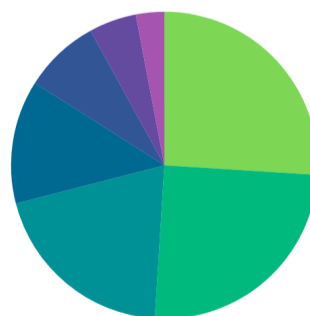
